Pre-employment Career Camp (Glynn County)

Program Overview:

The pre-employment Summer Career Camp is a dynamic, inclusive learning experience designed for students aged 14–21 who have an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or 504 Plan. This two-week program will introduce students to various career paths, strengthen workplace readiness skills, and foster independence through engaging hands-on activities, virtual industry visits, and guest speakers. Our camp is designed to prepare youth for future employment or post-secondary success in a supportive environment.

- Students aged **14–21**
- Must have an active **IEP or 504 Plan**
- Must turn in all required documentation by registration dates (on flyer)

Topics Covered:

- **Job Exploration:** Healthcare, Technology, Trades, Hospitality, Creative Arts, Public Services
- **Counseling on Enrollment opportunities:** post-secondary options, FAFSA, scholarships
- **Workplace Readiness:** Resume Building, Interview Practice, Job Search Strategies
- **Self-Advocacy:** Goal-setting, Self-awareness, Financial Literacy
- **Work Based Learning:** Local employers and career mentors will provide insight into real-world expectations.

Inclusions:

- **Daily Lunch Provided:** Students will receive a catered lunch each day (*in person camp*)
- **Travel Stipend:** Up to **\$25 per day** (maximum of **\$250**) to offset the cost of transportation. Families are responsible for arranging daily transportation to and from the camp. (*in person camp*)
