Project SEARCH is a unique, business led, one year High School-to-work transition program that takes place entirely in the workplace.

Total workplace immersion facilitates a seamless combination of classroom instruction, career exploration, and hands-on training through worksite rotations.

The program provides three 10 week internships tailored to each student intern's interests and career goals. Through the internships, each student will develop a plethora of skills and tools while exploring multiple employment sectors. This interest and skill building will be vital as we develop successful career paths.

THE GOAL

The goal of Project SEARCH is competitive, meaningful employment for each student participant.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

In order for this program to be successful, we rely on partnerships with people like you (managers, supervisors, and mentors) to provide real-world work experiences during three month rotations. This is made possible through the daily support provided by PASS through an on-site job coach.

THE PARTNERS

The program operates through a partnership between the local school district, PASS, Vocational Rehabilitation, and a host business site. These partners collaborate and support the interns as they work through the program offering customized training and guidance.
